Ordinance No. 5251

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE
OF A POOL DEHUMIDIFICATION UNIT FOR THE
AQUATICS FACILITY FROM THE K COMPANY, INC.
THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE
SERVICES PURCHASING PROGRAM; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Brecksville deems it cost effective to purchase certain services and equipment through the State of Ohio, Administrative Services Purchasing Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services - State Purchasing, through its authorized vendor, The K Company, Inc., for the purchase of the following:

SECTION 2. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with The K Company, Inc., as set forth in Section 1 hereof, said contract to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law.

SECTION 3. Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.



Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the need for the unit for the Aquatics Facility, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




