NEW BUSINESS

The Commission reviewed the test results submitted by Clancy and Associates for the Fire/Paramedic Candidates. The list of 57 candidates included 2 candidates who failed the test and 2 candidates who failed to show for the test. The commission voted to send the top 25 candidates on for polygraph testing. A deadline of January 6th, 2017 was given to the candidates to take the polygraph test.

Motion to send the first 25 candidates to polygraph was put forth by Chairman Greve and seconded by Robert Stiefvater.

The secretary was asked to gather more information on the psychological company, Pradco, and their deeper psychological testing that could be done for the firefighter candidates. This deeper testing could occur after the initial screening by the company.

The upcoming December 7th Sergeants promotional examination was discussed with a possible meeting of the Commission in the next two weeks to decide any challenges put forth by the candidates.
