Central School and the surrounding property will be transferred to the City from the Board of Education. Mayor Hruby said he will be placing the consideration to rezone the Central School property on the Planning Commission agenda. Mayor Hruby said the current zoning is for community facilities. Mayor Hruby said he would like the zoning to reflect what use is best for the property. Mayor Hruby would like a zoning proposal to be on the ballot for the voters to determine in 2019.

Mayor Hruby said the Board and Commission volunteer citizens do a tremendous job for the City in the decisions they make. The volunteers give their time and talent even knowing at times they may receive criticism from the public for the decisions made. Mayor Hruby thanked the Board and Commission members for their dedication to the City of Brecksville.
