The Brecksville Community Center staff welcomes you as a member in 2004 and hopes you will enjoy the use of our beautiful facility.

In order to maintain a safe and healthy environment, we are offering you information regarding fees and regulations. Please become familiar with them and keep this information as a reference guide.

Specific program information is available in the lobby as registration time for each program approaches.

The Center is a magnificent 48,000 sq. ft. structure features a stage, jogging track, basketball and volleyball courts. A fitness area, walking track, locker room facilities, saunas, whirlpool, day care, youth game room, kitchen, community room and passive lounge, also included is an indoor pool, and outdoor leisure pool and clock tower.

Field house is 10,650 sq. ft. with glass backboards, wood flooring, elevated track and two half size courts for volleyball and basketball.

The 25-yard Jack A. Hruby Natatorium features a one-meter diving board and has a series of glass doors that overlook the outdoor leisure pool. The skylights and wooden beams give the area a warm feeling year round. Adjacent to the pool is a whirlpool. Access to the outdoor leisure pool is gained through the indoor pool area. This pool has underwater seating and is four feet at its deep-end point and features a mushroom spray.

Fitness Area has free weights, cardiovascular and selectorized equipment. The 5,000 sq. ft. area also has a walking track which outlines the room and there is access to the jogging track.

The Game Room is equipped with a foos ball, ping pong, pool tables and speed hockey.

The Day Care Room is available to users of the center and features brightly colored furniture and accessories.

The Passive Lounge is located beneath the featured clock tower and offers relaxed seating.

The Community Rooms are available for rental to accommodate up to 150 persons and is equipped with kitchen facilities.

Men's and women's locker rooms include saunas. A special dressing room offers family members with small children a place to change without having some members of the group separated.

Vending machines are located near the main lobby.

Annual registration fees are prorated quarterly.

Two proofs of residency are required when registering.

Acceptable proofs include:

- Income or real estate tax statements.
- Utility Bill (water, sewer, electric, gas or telephone)
- Voter registration card
- Personal check

- College billing statement
- or grade card (for college membership)
- Report card (for student membership)

Guest Fee Policy Residents who have not paid an annual registration fee may enter for a guest fee.

Non-resident guests must be signed in by a member. Signing in guests is a privilege of membership.

PROGRAM REGISTRATION DATES

Registration for programs occurs four times a year. Programs that run on a continuous basis have registration more often.

The first week of registration is extended solely to Brecksville residents. Non-residents may sign up for programs after the first week.

FACILITY REGULATIONS

Building

- ▼ All visitors must report to the front desk.
- ▼ Members must scan a membership card upon entering the building.
- ▼ Misuse of membership privileges can result in confiscation of the card and immediate suspension.
- ▼ Children 9 years old and under must be accompanied by a parent or an adult (18 and older) at all times.
- ▼ Children 10 to 13 years old are permitted in the Community Center until 8:00 p.m. After 8:00 p.m. they must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult. Students 14 to 17 years old are permitted in the building until 9:30 p.m. After 9:30 p.m. they must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.
- ▼ Telephone calls to the Community Center are restricted to emergency calls. Pay phones are available for the convenience of members.
- ▼ Vandalism or defacing of property will not be tolerated; vandals will be prosecuted.
- ▼ Loitering or use of profanity in the facility or on the premises is not permitted.
- ▼ Alcohol is prohibited. Anyone under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs will be refused admission or asked to leave the premises.
- ▼ The Community Center is a non-smoking facility. City ordinance prohibits smoking in city buildings.
- ▼ Cassette type radios are permitted only when earphones are used.
- ▼ Proper attire is required before entering the building. Shoes and shirts are mandatory.
- ▼ Lost or misplaced membership cards must be replaced. A non-refundable fee of \$5 will be charged. If members do not have a card upon arrival, a temporary pass will be issued. Members are limited to four temporary passes before a replacement pass must be purchased.

- ▼ Membership cards are non-transferable. Violators are subject to prosecution.
- ▼ Cooperation in adhering to the rules is appreciated. Violators may be subject to suspension and/or cancellation of membership.

Locker Rooms

- ▼ Members and guests are encouraged to bring their own locks. Use of permanent locks on lockers is prohibited. Any locks left overnight will be cut off.
- ▼ Electric hair dryers are available.
- ▼ Soap is provided in shower areas.
- ▼ Patrons must provide their own towels.
- ▼ A family locker room is available for families with small children and those individuals with special needs.
- ▼ Food and beverages are prohibited.

Sauna

- ▼ We suggest showering before entering. You must be 18 years old to use the sauna.
- ▼ Persons with high or low blood pressure or those in otherwise poor health should consult a physician before use.
- ▼ Limit use to 5-10 minutes per session.
- ▼ If faintness or dizziness occurs, exit the sauna immediately.
- ▼ Jewelry or metal objects are not permitted.
- ▼ A towel or bathing suit must be worn.
- ▼ Do not wear contact lenses.
- ▼ Do not pour water on sauna rocks.

Field House

- ▼ Only registered members and guests may check out equipment. Basketballs can be signed out at the front desk.
- ▼ Only one full court basketball game (played on side court) is permitted.
The other portion of the field house will remain open when there are no scheduled recreational activities.
- ▼ When a recreational event is using half the field house, the other half will be used for open play.
No full court game will be permitted.
- ▼ Tennis shoes must be worn. Street shoes are prohibited.
- ▼ Food and beverages are prohibited.
- ▼ Profanity or misconduct of any kind is prohibited.
- ▼ Gym bags, jackets and all personal belongings should be placed in the locker room.
- ▼ There will be no dunking or hanging on the rims or nets.
- ▼ Passes may be revoked from an individual at any time for misuse of equipment or property.

Game Room

- ▼ The Game Room is equipped with foosball, ping pong, pool, table golf, speed hockey, chess, checkers board games and television.
- ▼ Any child age 7 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- ▼ Equipment may be signed out at the front desk by turning in a membership card or guest pass.
- ▼ No food or beverages are permitted.
- ▼ There will be no betting or wagering in the Community Center.
- ▼ If there is a wait for equipment please limit use to 10 minutes.

Pool

- ▼ Enter and exit the pool through the locker rooms.
- ▼ Running and horseplay are prohibited.
- ▼ No diving in the outdoor pool. Diving is permitted from the diving board only.
- ▼ Properly fitted life jackets, water wings, and buoyant swimsuits are permitted for instructional and special use only. A trusted adult must accompany children wearing flotation devices in the water at all times.
- ▼ All pools will temporarily close in the event of lightning and thunder.
- ▼ Pool equipment such as diving rings, kick boards or toys, are to be used at the discretion of life guards on duty.
- ▼ Children age 9 and any child needing assistance must be accompanied by an adult into the pool area.
- ▼ Food and beverages are permitted in the grass area of the outdoor pool only.
- ▼ Glass and sharp items are prohibited in either pool areas
- ▼ Do not hang on steps, rails, lifelines or lane lines.
- ▼ Starting blocks are restricted to competitive and instructional programs.
- ▼ Masks, fins and snorkels are permitted for lap swimming only. Crowd size and proper use are determinants for such equipment.
- ▼ Only soft-style balls are permitted.
- ▼ All accidents, incidents or discipline problems should immediately be reported to a staff member.
- ▼ We encourage patrons to shower before entering the pool.
- ▼ Individuals under age 15 are not permitted in the hot tub.

Diving

- ▼ One person at a time on the board.
- ▼ Wait for the person ahead of you to reach the ladder or wall before approaching the board.
- ▼ Jump straight in front of the board—not off the side.
- ▼ Only forward jumps, dives and flips are permitted. Flips are limited to singles without twists.

Fitness

- ▼ Proper attire, including shirts and shoes, are required
- ▼ Rack all weights after use.
- ▼ Do not bang weights together or drop them on the floor.
- ▼ Wipe off machines after use.
- ▼ The use of chalk, or misconduct of any kind is prohibited.
- ▼ Water containers are permitted. All other food and beverages are strictly prohibited.
- ▼ Offensive language or behavior is prohibited.
- ▼ The time limit on the cardiovascular machines is 30 minutes.
- ▼ Patrons must be 15 years of age to work out in the fitness area or participate in fitness programs. Those who are 13 and 14 who have successfully completed the Introduction to Exercise Program may be permitted to utilize the fitness area and the jogging track. Anyone 14 or under who has not completed the class may not use the fitness area, even under the supervision of a parent. This policy is strictly enforced to avoid injuries to youngsters.
- ▼ Please use a locker to secure personal belongings.
- ▼ A closet is located in the fitness area for your convenience.
- ▼ Participants must bring their own towels.
- ▼ Personal trainers must be approved by the Fitness Coordinator prior to working with members at the Center.
