**A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING ALL FUNDS FROM THE
AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 BE EXPENDED ONLY
TO COVER COSTS OF THE CITY CONSISTENT WITH THE
REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 603(c)(1) OF THE ACT, CREATING
THE LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND 212, AND INCREASING
ESTIMATED RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATION IN FUND 212;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Pub. L. No. 117-2) (ARPA) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 11, 2021; and

WHEREAS, section 9901 of ARPA amended Title VI of the Social Security Act to add section 602, which establishes the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, and section 603, which establishes the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (together, the Fiscal Recovery Funds); and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Recovery Funds are intended to provide support to State, local and Tribal governments in responding to the impact of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain COVID-19 on their communities, residents, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the city has been awarded its share of Fiscal Recovery Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brecksville is estimated to receive \$1,425,033.42 paid in two equal tranches of \$712,516.71 with the first payment to be received on or about August 1, 2021 and the second payment to be made no earlier than 12 months after the date on which the first payment is made; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a separate fund entitled Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (212) to obtain separate accountability for Fiscal Recovery Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. All funds received from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 shall be expended only to cover costs of the city consistent with the requirements of section 603(c)(1) of the ARPA as described in H.R. 1319, and any applicable regulations and guidance only to cover expenses that:

- (1) to respond to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid to impacted industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality;
- (2) to respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency by providing premium pay to eligible workers of the metropolitan city, nonentitlement unit of local government, or county that are performing such essential work, or by providing grants to eligible employers that have eligible workers who perform essential work;
- (3) for the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue of such metropolitan city, nonentitlement unit of local government, or county due to the COVID-19 public health emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year of the metropolitan city, nonentitlement unit of local government, or county prior to the emergency; or
- (4) to make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure.

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SECTION 2. The Director of Finance be authorized and directed to establish the Local Fiscal Recovery Fund 212 for the accounting of funds from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.


SECTION 3. The Director of Finance be authorized to increase estimated resources and appropriation in Fund 212, Local Fiscal Recovery Fund 212, as follows:

R212150-0819	Misc Grant – Federal	\$712,516.71
212150-2814	Misc Grant Expenditures	\$712,516.71

SECTION 4. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the need to affirm that funds from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 are expended only to cover costs of the city consistent with the requirements of section 603(c)(1) of the ARPA, create Fund 212 and increase estimated resources and appropriation in Fund 212, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


