**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY  
FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE U.S DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE TO  
CONDUCT A PLANNING STUDY TO ADVANCE THE  
CONNECTIVITY OF BRECKSVILLE ROAD;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Transportation's Reconnecting Communities Pilot Discretionary Grant Program grants are to be awarded for projects that reconnect communities by removing, retrofitting, or mitigating highways or other transportation facilities that create barriers to community connectivity, including mobility, access, or economic development; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding would present an opportunity to conduct a planning study to advance the connectivity of Brecksville Road, with a focus on the Downtown/Civic district and assets located along the adjacent to the corridor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:


**SECTION 1.** The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply, on behalf of the City of Brecksville, for a grant through the U.S. Department of Transportation for funding assistance to conduct a planning study to advance the connectivity of Brecksville Road. The Mayor is further authorized to execute whatever documents are needed in furtherance of this grant application. In addition, in the event the City of Brecksville is successful in securing this grant, the Mayor is further authorized to execute whatever documents and to take the necessary steps to effectuate the receipt of these grant funds and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to credit the proceeds of any grant to the appropriately designated Fund.


**SECTION 2.** The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is to make a timely application, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
