**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY TO THE
NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY (NOACA)
THROUGH THEIR TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE COMMUNITIES
INITIATIVE (TLCI) FOR FUNDING TO CONSTRUCT SIDEWALKS ON
CHIPPEWA ROAD (SR 82) FROM CINNABAR DRIVE TO RIVERVIEW
ROAD AND ADA PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CHIPPEWA
ROAD/RIVERVIEW ROAD INTERSECTION; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, NOACA's Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative provides federal funds to communities and public agencies for integrated transportation and land use planning and projects that strengthen community livability; and

WHEREAS, NOACA will issue awards funded at a maximum 80% of the total project budget, and if requested funds are granted, the city shall be responsible for at least twenty (20%) percent of the eligible costs

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor, be, and hereby is, authorized to apply to the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) through their Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative for funding to construct sidewalks on Chippewa Road (SR82) from Cinnabar Drive to Riverview Road and ADA pedestrian improvements to the Chippewa Road/Riverview Road intersection and to execute whatever documents are necessary to complete the application process. If successful in obtaining funding, the Mayor is authorized to execute whatever documents are necessary to effectuate the receipt of funds.


SECTION 2. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is that it relates to the need to meet the deadline for the application of October 6, 2023, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


