Resolution No. 5029

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO APPLY FOR SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANTS
THROUGH THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION
TO FUND NEW SAFETY RELATED EQUIPMENT FOR THE FIRE
DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Workers' Compensation awards safety grants to employers for the purchase of ergonomic, safety and/or industrial equipment to help reduce or eliminate injuries and illnesses; and

WHEREAS, with the safety intervention grant, employers are eligible for a 3-to-1 matching grant, up to a maximum of \$40,000 per eligibility cycle, which means the Bureau of Workers' Compensation gives \$3 for every \$1 the employer contributes.


.NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply for Safety Intervention Grants through the Bureau of Workers' Compensation to fund new safety related equipment for the Fire Department. The Mayor is further authorized to execute whatever documents are necessary to complete the application process and, if successful in obtaining a grant, the Mayor is authorized to execute whatever documents are necessary to effectuate the receipt of grant funds.

SECTION 2. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


