WINTER WEATHER

I hope you all are continuing to stay safe and warm during this mild snowstorm. There remains a Winter Weather Advisory throughout the remainder of the day into Saturday, January 14th, at 1:00 am. They are calling for a possible additional 2 to 4 inches of snow with winds around 30 mph. The hazardous conditions could impact your evening commute. We ask that you slow down and use caution while traveling. The threat will subside throughout the weekend.



PROPERTY TAX BILL

Due to the delay in the mailing of Property Tax Bills, the due date has been extended to January 26, 2023.

There are several options to pay:

- By mail, with parcel number written on the check, to: Cuyahoga County Treasurer, P.O. Box 94547, Cleveland, OH, 44115. *(Envelope must be postmarked by closing date to avoid penalties and interest)*
- Online via e-check or credit card at [Cuyahoga County Treasurer](#)
- By phone at 1-877-738-1212. *(There will be a fee added to credit card payments or e-checks are free)*
- By drop box, located on the side of the Cuyahoga County Administrative building at 2079 E. Ninth St., first floor. *(This is available 24 hours a day, check or money orders only)*
- In person at the administrative building cashier station or self-pay kiosk on the first floor on weekdays, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Extended hours 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Jan. 26. *(Accepts cash or check)*
- All Key Bank branches in Cuyahoga County through Jan. 19
- Auto title branches *(check the county's website for hours of operation)*
