As a follow up to yesterday's National Weather Service Flood Warning for our region, the National Weather Service has now posted a Winter Weather Advisory from 4:00 pm today, February 17th to 7:00 am, Friday, February 18th. Rain this afternoon and early evening is to begin to change to freezing rain at approximately 7:00 pm for a short period of time. After which the freezing rain and sleet will change to snow. Throughout night and early into Friday morning they are predicting 3-4" of snowfall. The main concern will be the period between rain and snow when ice will coat our roads, trees and power lines. Fortunately, they are saying that this condition may only last an hour or two and the snowfall will follow as stated.

As predicted in yesterday's e-mail, the Cuyahoga River is cresting in certain areas. Water is flowing across Vaughn Road and in the areas of Riverview Road, Wiese Road, and Greenhaven. Try to avoid those areas as, most likely, those roads will be closed. Hopefully the forecasted flooding will not be as bad as yesterday's prediction.
