SCHOOL BEGINS

Brecksville-Broadview Heights School District will commence classes on Tuesday, September 6th. We ask that you adhere to the school zone speed limit of 20 mph, and that you comply with the law governing stopping for school busses. Plus, we ask you to be cautious with students walking and or riding their bikes to school. We welcome the new teachers and staff as we welcome back the returning staff and teachers. We wish you all a successful start to school. Due to the opening of the new Elementary School on Oakes Road, the combined starting times for the Middle School and High School on Mill Road, in conjunction with construction in our downtown, expect congestion and delays. Pay close attention to the new signage both on the interior property of the schools and the City streets and intersections. Please exercise caution. Drive safely and within the speed limits.



DOMINION GAS MAIN REPLACEMENT

The Gas Main Replacement Project on Brecksville Road, Route 21, from the center of town north, is expected to continue for the next two weeks. Hopefully, next week they will be pushing the gas line underground, a process which will take 24-48 hours of consecutive work. We suggest to our motorists to avoid the area of 21 & Mill Road when our schools are opening in the morning and closing in the afternoon. We thank you for your continued patience for this inconvenience of the Gas Main Project and the City Road Program for 2022 which is now completed.



CHIPPEWA ROAD & CALVIN DRIVE SANITARY PROJECT

The anticipated Chippewa Road & Calvin Drive Sanitary Project should start construction within the next week or so. The first activity will be clearing of the entire work area along Chippewa Road, Route 82, starting at Riverview Road. Here also, please drive safely and expect some delays. You may select to find an alternate route rather than drive through this construction area.
